





2025 Accomplishments

Restoration in Progress



In November we were unanimously approved for zoning with the city of Philadelphia to begin the renovation process of our cottage. To date, the existing walls and finishes have been removed including the old brick fireplace and chimney in preparation to convert the interior into two, two bedroom apartments. All five dormers have been completely reconstructed and second floor windows installed.

All the work has been done by volunteers from Immanuel Leidy's Church, including supplying an architect to provide construction drawings for pricing and submission to the historical commission and now we build!



Private Commercial Playground



Due to the generosity of our partners, in July we installed a commercial playground. This was a dream come true. What joy it is to see children return home with their mothers running with excitement to the back of our property to play. What a pleasure to look outside and see families

with blankets spread, picnicking, while hearing the carefree laughter of children. What a blessing to provide our children with a safe, private, place to play. We are so grateful for this wonderful asset to our home that supports physical and mental health and good ole' fashioned quality family time.

Ceiling Reconstruction



New ceilings were installed in our dining hall and chapel due to collapsed structure. We are in the process of getting estimates to replace our roof which has begun to leak on our new ceiling and caused disrepair.

2025 Accomplishments

Pointing - We completed much needed pointing on the home to repair the mortar joints between the bricks. This enhances our structure and weatherproofing of our home which reduces utility costs and maintenance.

Retaining wall – Our property has an abundance of hedges and grass which required our retaining wall be restored to hold the soil and maintain our landscape. The retaining wall also provides a base for new fencing that we had installed for the safety of our children and to protect the home.




